The Parish Council plays a vital role within the Parish, working towards keeping the parish an attractive place to live and can influence the future of the area. We provide and maintain street lighting, recreation grounds, litter and dog waste bins.

We consult on planning matters, highways issues and campaign for and deliver better services and facilities, liaising closely with the Borough and County Councils.

Meetings are held monthly (apart from July and December), rotating between the three villages in the Parish, with occasional other meetings.

Training and support are available.

To qualify, you need to:

- be a UK or commonwealth citizen, or;
- be a citizen of the Republic of Ireland, or;
- be a citizen of another Member state of the European Union;
- be at least 18 years old.
- be an elector of the parish (registered on the Electoral Roll), or;
- for the whole of the previous 12 months have occupied (as owner or tenant) land or other premises in the parish, or; during the previous 12 months have worked in the parish (as your principal or only place of work), or; for the whole of the previous 12 months lived in the parish or within three miles of the parish boundary.
